

## PMI MANUFACTURING SUSTAINABILITY COMMITMENT

At Philip Morris International we provide working conditions that help prevent work-related injury and illness and protect the environment. To achieve these aims we commit to:

- Consult our employees and, where they exist, workers' representatives;
- Involve each employee through our "*Safety is In*" program; the program is designed to create a safe and secure work environment through a culture of personal responsibility and good leadership by positioning Safety as the core value withing factory premises and beyond;
- Reduce the production of waste, ensuring its safe disposal, and encouraging, wherever possible, its reuse or recycling;
- Reduce carbon footprint through a number of initiatives, including operational efficiency improvement, and the increased use of renewable energy;
- Be more sustainable in our water usage;
- Comply with all applicable environmental laws and our own environmental, health, and safety requirements; laws take priority in the case of incompatibility;
- Be transparent in our environmental, health, and safety performance reporting;
- Enhance the performance of our environmental, health, and safety management system through *plan-do-check-act* continuous improvement process;
- Maintain ISO 14001:2015 and ISO 45001:2018 integrated certification programs in relevant PMI manufacturing centers.

## The path to achieve these commitments is through the implementation of our environmental, health, and safety requirements, and in particular through ensuring that the requirements are:

- Appropriate for and aligned with PMI manufacturing centers' environmental, health, and safety risks and opportunities;
- Adjusted to the nature, scale, and environmental impact of PMI manufacturing centers' activities, products, and services;
- Providing for specific, minimum performance standards, that are reviewed periodically;
- Prioritizing and integrating action plans with quantified targets to address environmental, health, and safety risks;
- Evaluating progress in reducing and preventing health risks, and environmental impact against defined targets;
- Integrating action plans to prepare for, and respond to, emergency situations;
- Reinforcing applicable rules and standards through internal inspections and audits;
- Mandating investigations on work-related injuries, ill health, diseases, and environmental, health, and safety incidents, including completing and following-up on corrective actions;
- Requiring escalation of any non-conformities, for prompt attention and resolution.
